

Camp Features:

- Quality Staff – Our staff differentiates us from other camps in the Trenton area. Our camps are led by our fulltime professional staff members who are assisted by teachers and aides from the area.
- Hours – The camp day is from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Field Trips – Every week, camps take field trips that are related to their camping activities. Transportation is by our school bus. Trip fees are included in the weekly tuition.
- Swimming – Every week campers will get recreational swim time in the outdoor pool at the Club. Non-swimmers take a swim-safe program for beginners.
- Transportation -- The camp provides free transportation to and from our Centre Street Club every day from six city locations. Transportation is by school bus, with pick-up between 7:45 and 8:30 a.m. Return trips are between 4:15 and 5:00 p.m.
- Free Breakfast and Lunch – Through an arrangement with the City of Trenton, qualifying campers receive free breakfast and lunch while at camp from July 5 through August 18, 2006.

Adventure Camp - Ages 5 to 11 years Weekly session from June 26 to August 18

Children who attend base camp get a well-rounded camp experience each week. They swim, play sports, do arts and crafts, spend time in our computer and education centers, and learn life skills in our Smart Moves program.

Sports Camp - Ages 6 to 12 years (Centre Street) Weekly sessions from June 26 to August 18

Each day, campers participate in variety of sports. The mornings are devoted to skill instruction and scrimmages, while the afternoons involve games, activities, and swimming.

Throughout the week, campers spend time playing basketball, baseball, soccer, swimming, floor hockey, and other sports. Additional activities include computers, life skills, Smart Moves substance awareness program, and programs in our education center.

Teen Travel - Ages 12 to 15 year olds Weekly sessions from June 26 to August 11

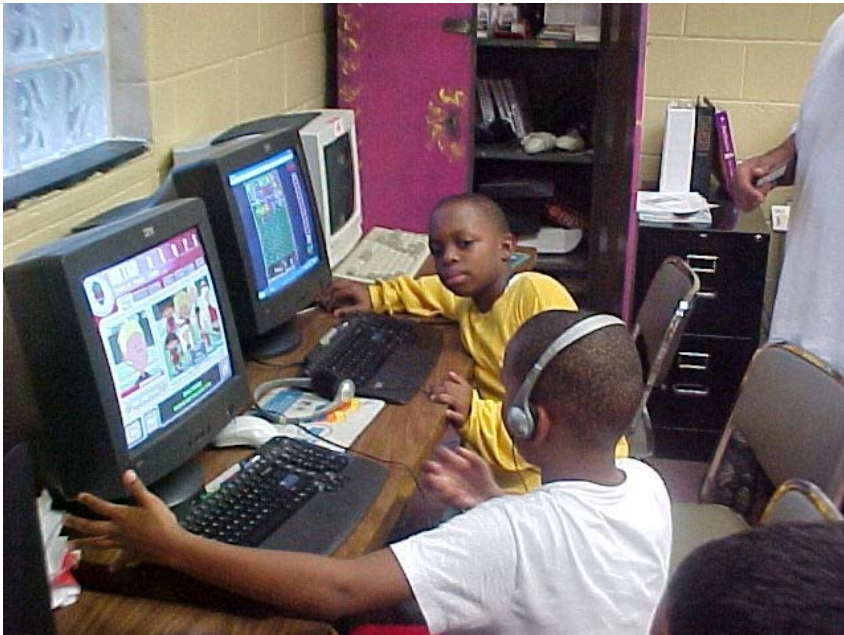
Teen Travel programs combine a week full of trips, along with community service projects, life skills, team building, sports, and Smart Moves substance abuse awareness program. How to Register – You can register for one week or the entire summer. A \$10 deposit is required for each week that you would like to reserve. Call or stop by our office to register. All fees are based on a sliding scale relating to family income and ability-to-pay.

Scholarships – The Boys and Girls Club of Trenton & Mercer County provides more than \$100,000 in scholarship assistance to help anyone who needs financial help to participate in our summer programs. Scholarships are awarded on a sliding scale based on family income and size. Application deadline is May 15.

Parent's Night June 13 – Provides parents with an orientation that describes what happens during a typical camp day. Highly recommended for parents of first time campers. Takes place between 6 and 7 p.m.
